Tiffin University's finance curriculum strikes a balance between applications and theory, providing you real-world experience that employers desire. Our students learn finance using real-time market data and cutting-edge software in our Finance Lab. The lab will prepare you for the realities you will encounter in the workforce as a professional portfolio manager and financial researcher. Through your coursework and training in the Finance Lab, you will gain skills and knowledge to make decisions, value assets, analyze the financial performance of firms and determine strategies to enhance the value of the business.

Tiffin University's finance curriculum helps to prepare you for professional examinations, such as the chartered financial analyst (CFA), certified financial planner (CFP) or chartered financial consultant exams. Approximately 20% of our finance students choose to obtain a second major in accounting in four years of study, which provides a strong basis for the Certified Managerial Accountant (CMA) exam.

The demand for employment for finance is expected to rise 19 percent between 2016 and 2026. The median annual wage for financial managers was \$127,990 in May 2018.

INTERNSHIPS

All finance majors are required to complete an internship consisting of a minimum of 150 hours. We have placed students at Marathon Petroleum, PricewaterhouseCoopers, Huston Financial Services, Cardinal Health, Avita Health System, Elmo Sweden AB and Shanghai Pudong Dev Bank. These internships often lead to permanent full-time employment.
