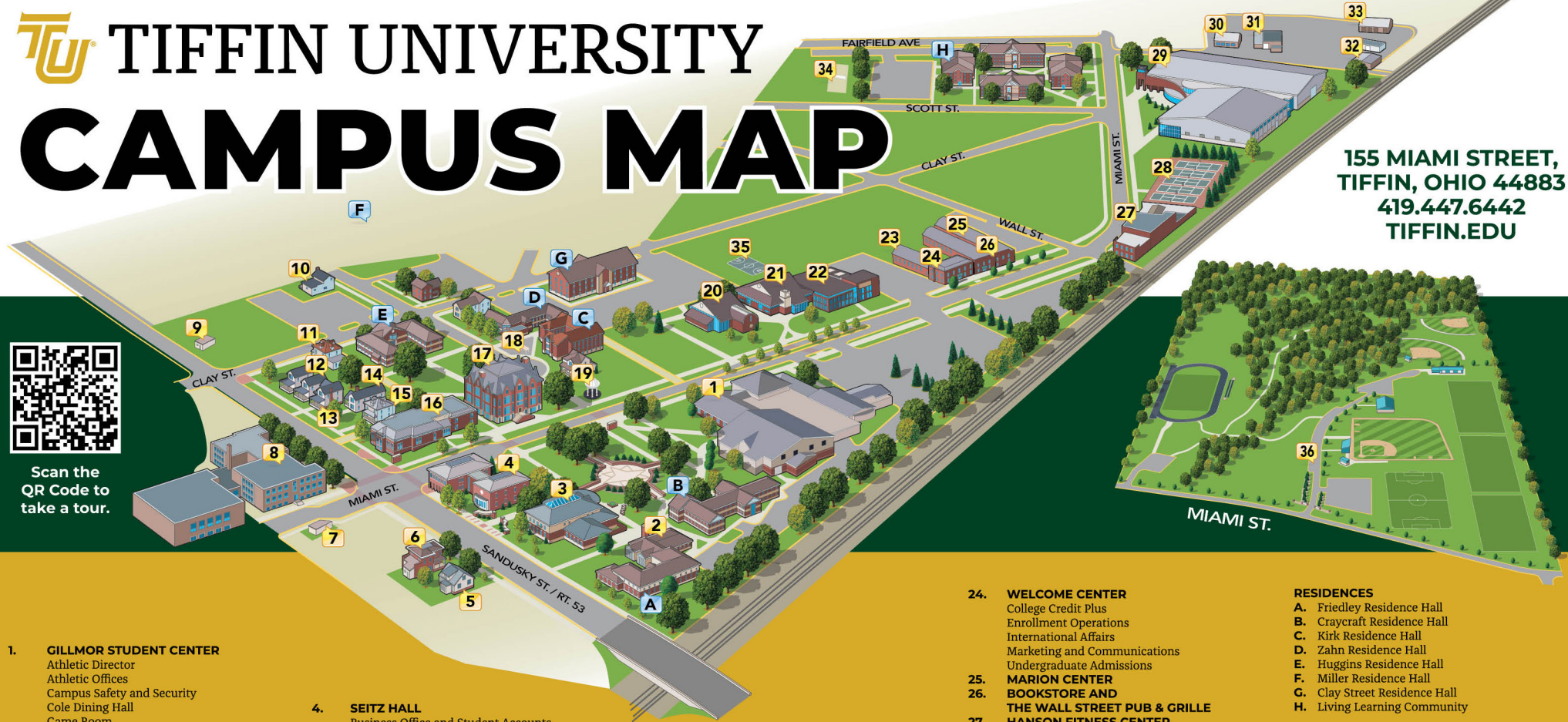


TIFFIN UNIVERSITY CAMPUS MAP
