

Tiffin University Receives U.S. Department of Education Grant

TU has been awarded over \$2.24 million over five years from the U.S. Department of Education. The U.S. Department of Education Title III Grant – Strengthening Institutions Program (SIP) is designed to help higher education institutions expand their capacity to serve at-risk students by providing funds to improve and strengthen the institution's academic quality, institutional management and fiscal stability.



Some of the projects that will be executed include the development of a university master plan, creation of new study spaces, purchasing computers, technology and furnishings, an Al chatbot, a Student Early Alert System, as well as additional student support personnel.


Inspiring young entrepreneurs with start-up money for their own business.

space utilization to improve student engagement and support activities.

For entrepreneurially minded students who want to start their own company, the TIP program is a three-month program designed to inspire and educate. Starting in January, 2022, selected on-campus and online students will meet once a week to learn how to develop and launch an innovative start-up company. Speakers will include established high-profile entrepreneurs like TU Board Member,



Danial Jameel, Founder & President at Ready Education, a leading student engagement platform for higher education.



Students are encouraged to create teams, that may include non-students. Classes will be every Wednesday from 6 to 9 p.m., starting January 26, 2022 and run through April 27, 2022. After completing the program, one winning team will be selected to receive funding in start-up costs for their company. Students must apply for the program and pitch an idea to get accepted.

TIP allows students to gain real-world experience, learn from failure, take calculated risks, develop grit and collaborate in diverse teams – essential skill sets that cannot be learned inside the classroom.

TIP will also help to improve the Tiffin economy, as well as promote an entrepreneur ecosystem in the community. There will be a demonstration day to present projects to the wider Tiffin community and potential investors.

Tiffin University is partnering with Lean Systems Inc. to offer a lean manufacturing program comprised of 6, in-person, modules. Lean Systems Inc. is a team of continuous improvement experts that teach leadership, systems, and transformation as well as assist in



the assessment and implementation of cultural transformation. The Lean Systems program is approved by the State of Ohio and NAFTA. The program begins February 1, 2022.

This program is being offered through TU Connects. TU Connects is an initiative that is focused on all aspects of workforce readiness from a "local to global" perspective.

Graduate Alumni Discount
